

Date	War	Description
1540-41	Tiguex War	First war between Europeans and Native Americans (Tiwa Indians)
March 22, 1622	Jamestown Massacre	Powhatan Indians kill 347 English settlers in VA colony
1622-44	Powhatan Wars	Conflict between Powhatan Indians and English settlers in Virginia
1636-37	Pequot War	The death of a colonist led to the destruction of 600-700 natives. The remainder were sold into slavery
1675-76	King Philip's War	Conflict over colonist's expansionist activities that left 600 colonists and 3,000 Native Americans dead.
1680-92	Pueblo Revolt	Pueblo Indians rebelled against Spanish and lived independently for 12 years. The Spanish re-conquered in 1692.
1689-1763	French and Indian war	First of the French and Indian Wars. Fight between England and France, and their respective American Indian allies
1715-18	Yamasee War	Yamasee Indians came close to exterminating a white settlement on their land
1763	Pontiac's Rebellion	War Chief Pontiac vs. British
1776-94	Chickamauga Wars	Series of conflicts between Cherokee and White settlers
August 18, 1813	Battle of Frenchtown	Severe defeat for Americans during War of 1812 by Shawnee Indians

1816-18	First Seminole War	Seminole fight Andrew Jackson's force, Jackson failed, but forced Spanish to relinquish territory
1817	Battle of Claremore Mound	Cherokee Indians wipe out Osage Indians
1832	Black Hawk War	Last native conflict in the area. Unsuccessful attempt to move back to their homeland in Illinois
August 1, 1832	Battle of Bad Axe	300 Indian men, women and children are killed by white soldiers
1835-42	Second Seminole War	Seminole resume fighting for land in Florida. Seminoles nearly eliminated.
1836-75	Comanche Wars	US Military instituted official campaigns against Comanche tribes
1839	Cherokee War	culmination of tension between Cherokee, Kickapoo, and Shawnee Indians and the White settlers in Texas
1848-55	Cayuse War	Conflict between Cayuse and white settlers that was caused in part by influx of disease
1849-63	Navajo Conflicts	Persistent fighting between Navajo and US Army in Arizona and New Mexico. Led to expulsion and incarceration to a reservation
1854-90	Sioux Wars	Conflict between the Sioux and white settlers in South Dakota and Wyoming
1855- 58	Third Seminole War	Final stand against US in Florida. Seminoles deported to Indian Reservations in Oklahoma
1867-75	Comanche Campaign	Major General Philip Sheridan's campaign to root out elusive Indian tribes scattered throughout the West

1876-77	Black Hills War/ Sioux War of 1876	Lakota fought US after violations of the 1868 Treaty of Fort Laramie
September 29, 1879	Meeker Massacre	One of the most violent expressions of Indian resentment toward the reservation system, Ute Indians attacked White River Indian Agency.
Nov 1890- Jan 1891	Pine Ridge Campaign	Unresolved grievances led to the last major conflict with the Sioux. Sioux retreated back to reservation
October 5, 1898	Battle of Leech Lake	Considered the last "Indian War" Uprising of Chippewa in Minnesota
